Park Information & Rules

Accounts

To be paid in full on day of arrival. No refunds for early departures.

Activities

Guided Night Walks, booking services, brochures and maps from reception.

Alcohol & Parties

No liquor is to be consumed in the Park, except within your site, or in your unit. Excessive drinking and parties are forbidden in the Park and offenders will be requested to leave with no refunds.

Barbecues

Free BBQs are available outside the kitchen and in the Outdoor Kitchen. After use, please leave clean for next guests.

Children

Children to be controlled by parents at all times and supervised while using facilities. While in water children MUST be supervised.

Check In / Out

Check in time: 1.00pm – 8.00pm. Late check in can be arranged by contacting the office in advance. Check out time 10.00am. Extensions of stay or late check outs MUST be arranged with the Manager.

Conduct

Reasonable behaviour and dress expected at all times. Consideration must be shown to other guests.

Conservation

Please help us care for the environment by conserving hot water and reusing linen where possible. Please limit shower times to 5 minutes, and strictly NO vehicle washing allowed on site.

Damage

Please notify Reception of any damage to property. Guests will be charged for damage incurred.

Dump Station

Campervans and caravans must use the Dump Station to dispose of grey water and waste. The Dump Station is located on exit road on left hand side.

Excess Cleaning Charge

You are required to leave your accommodation in a clean and tidy condition. An excess charge of up to \$50 may be incurred if deemed necessary, as well as professional cleaning and repair services as required.

Fishing

You will require a valid fishing permit to fish in the rivers here. NO FISHING in the area between the

swimming hole and Opouteke bridge during the summer season when guests are swimming in the rivers. NO FISHING for eels – they are our pets. Please ask at reception for further details.

Fire Safety

Tents, Caravans, Motorhomes and all other structures must be 1.5m from shared site boundaries: No fireworks at any time: Braziers and BBQ's dependent on fire season – please check at reception before lighting. fire can spread quickly on a camp ground and any fire or appliance deemed to be unsafe must be extinguished immediately.

Fridges

All food in communal fridges to be named, covered and removed before departure.

Gate

The gate is closed around 10.00pm – 11.00pm at night. It is not locked, so if you return or leave when it is closed please quietly open the gate and close behind you.

Internet

WiFi is available on site. FREE 250MB data per device per 24 hours for all guests. 500MB additional data for TOP 10 Club Members. Paid plans available from reception or online for additional data.

Laundry

\$3 per wash and \$3 per dryer. The machines are coin operated and take gold coins only. Powder available from Reception (\$1 per sachet). Laundry closed between 10.00pm and 7.30am.

Pets

Welcome subject to Park rules – a copy is available at Reception. Please let us know if you have a pet with you. Strictly no pets in buildings, cabins and motels.

Nature Trail

Pick up a copy of our FREE Nature Trail from reception and learn more about the Flora, Fauna and Wildlife here on the Park as you stroll around our beautiful grounds.

Playground

Playground will open at 8.30am and close at dark. No bikes to be ridden anywhere on site after dark. STRICTLY ONLY 2 PERSONS ON TRAMPOLINES AT ALL TIMES! Please ensure your children are supervised and all signage in the area is followed.

Quiet Time

STRICTLY BETWEEN 10.30pm AND 7.30am. The kitchen, laundry and playgrounds are closed during these times. Quiet time is strictly enforced at all times.

Privacy Act

Unless you instruct us in writing to the contrary,

we will confirm to any person who enquires that you are a guest and if asked will direct them to your site or unit.

Rivers

There is a swimming hole in the river and tubes are available for hire. All water based sports and activities are carried out at your own risk. Children MUST be supervised when close to or in the water. You must leave the river at the latest by the concrete bridge over Opouteke Road. Please note that swimming in the rivers up to 48 hours after heavy rain is not advised because of possible upstream pollution.

Shop

Our onsite shop in reception stocks basic items such as bread, milk, ice and icecreams as well as toiletries, canned and packet foods. Enough to make your breakfast or supper any day!

Sites

Please ensure all your equipment and vehicles are within your site boundaries. If you can't fit your vehicles/trailer/boat on your site please report to reception.

Smoking

All Park buildings are SMOKEFREE.

Speed

Walking pace only in Park. Watch out for children!!

Services

Tents wanting to connect to power must have approved RCD lead. Caravans and campervans must have a current electrical warrant of fitness to connect to the power, and must provide their own waste container.

Sports Equipment Hire

Free hire on all sports equipment including tubes, petanque set, basketball and table tennis bats – all available from reception. \$5 returnable bond payable per item.

Telephone

Public phone available on site. Phone cards are available from office, or credit cards accepted.There is a hot spot for Spark and Vodafone customers in the area around reception, elsewhere on the Park there is no mobile reception.

Visitors

Day charges apply. All visitors must report to Reception. Guest visitors must depart by 8.00pm. Cars to be left outside main gate.
